Environmental Education Program Facts

Since 1994 – over 12,000 students have participated in over 400 water quality monitoring field trips, cleaned up 10 miles of stream banks and planted over 10,000 native trees and 2,000 prairie plants.

During the 2007 – 2008 school year – over 600 students have participated in 20 classroom presentations, 38 water quality monitoring field trips and 14 community service projects with the help of over 50 adult volunteers.

Since starting the Mill Creek Freedom Trees Program in 2004 – Students have planted 650 Freedom Trees at Mill Creek Freedom Groves.
